**Membership Requirements - To meet our insurance obligations riders must be members of the:-**

- (I) Henty Riding Club Inc. (It can be a one event membership)
- (II) Members of the EWA or

## **Saturday - Day 1 of the clinic**

Arrive before 8.30 for a 9am start. Please come to the club rooms to pay ground fees and fill out the EFA public liability form.

EFA and Henty Membership, club membership cards will be required!! No exceptions.....

Ground fees are \$7 per horse for the 3 days

\$5 per day camping fee per day per person

**Could you please make it easier for me by putting your fees in an envelope with your name on it and what the money is for, it gets very hectic with everyone arriving at once.**

## **Sunday Night - Dinner at the Dardanup Tavern -6.30pm**

If you and your family would like to join us for dinner at the **Dardanup Tavern** please put your name down on the list on Saturday morning and we can ring through with numbers.

## **Dogs**

Please leave your dogs at home we have a "No dogs on the grounds" policy.

**Yards -** Do not use the round pen or the small arena for housing your horse. You may use the camp draft yards (except the "camp") at the other end of the ground. There may be cattle in the paddocks, so please leave gates shut at all times.

## **Tea and Coffee**

We have tea and coffee for your convenience, please serve yourself and clean up as you go.

## **Manure**

Please clean up yards and pick up all manure and old hay - dump it in the manure heaps. There are wheel barrows and rakes provided. Bring your own "Poop Scoop"

## **Cleaning the club rooms and the arena**

It would be a huge help to me if you could all pitch in at the end of the clinic and clean the club rooms. We usually sweep and mop and tidy the place up. Bathrooms and kitchen etc. Many hands make light work and if everyone helps I estimate it will take 15 minutes. On my own 4 hours!! After the last clinic the place looked fantastic. The arena needs clearing of any equipment we use.
